- ✓ Minimum 18 years of Age
- ✓ Registered as a Category **B** Coach
- ✓ Complete Swimming Canada registration and sign Acknowledgement & Assumption of Risk Form
- ✓ Complete CSCA registration and screening questions
- ✓ Submit a Criminal Record Check (valid for 5 years)
- ✓ Complete Safe Sport Training (valid for 5 years)

NCCP Minimum Requirements:

Attending Club Invitationals and Provincial Meets **ONLY**

- Complete Swimming 101 Course
- Complete Fundamental Coach Portfolio
- Complete Making Ethical Decisions training and online evaluation
