Qualifications

Duties

1. Organized, enthusiastic, self-motivated, great teacher and dedicated to their role within the club;
2. Lead own training groups, and from time to time be required to be responsible for travelling or special teams as determined by the Head Coach;
3. Attend all practices, training camps and competitions in which your swimmers participate or as directed;
4. Shall be responsible to and take direction from the Head Coach, and in the absence of the Head Coach, shall assume such duties stipulated by the Head Coach of the Club Board;
5. Be a positive influence to members of the club and public;

The club offers a competitive salary range of \$50,000-\$56,000 per year, commensurate with experience and aligned with Swim BC market standards. Professional development support and relocation assistance may be available.
