

2025-2026 SWIM BC PACIFIC PEAKS PATHWAY OUTLINE

Program Overview

Swim BC provides support the Coach–Swimmer tandem by providing resources, services, and programs throughout the season. The programs have been defined in two areas:

Olympic Program Swimming Olympic Program swimmers are defined as able bodied swimmer.

Para Swimming Para swimmers are swimmers with a physical, visual, or intellectual impairment

and who have been classified by Swimming Canada.

For swimmers to be eligible for Swim BC Pacific Peaks Pathway programming, they are required to be registered members in good standing with a registered Swim BC club in a Competitive or Varsity category, have a designated coach who is responsible for their overall programming and daily training environment, and must be training full-time in BC or the Yukon.

Process

Swimmers will be identified based on performances achieved during designated eligibility periods. Selected swimmers will be notified through their Coach of Record. Participation is contingent on completion of the athlete intake process, after which athletes will be invited to access program-specific initiatives.

Nomination Cycle

The athlete and coach nomination cycle runs September 1st – August 31st annually.

- Member in Good Standing: A registered member in good standing with a registered Swim BC club and have a designated coach who is responsible for the overall programming and daily training environment. Training full-time in BC or the Yukon.
- Residency: Swimmers must be a permanent resident of British Columbia or Yukon, defined as a citizen of Canada or lawfully admitted to Canada for permanent residence; must make their home in BC or Yukon; and must be physically present in BC on Yukon at least six months in a calendar year.

IDENTIFICATION

Eligible swimmers who achieve Swim BC Next Wave time standards in three (3) or more events between September 1, 2024 – August 31, 2025, will be selected to the Swim BC Next Wave Provincial Team.

IDENTIFICATION

Priority 1

Eligible swimmers who achieve Swim BC Prospects time standards in three (3) or more events between September 1, 2024 – August 31, 2025, will be selected to the Swim BC Prospects Provincial Team up to a total of 30 Females and 30 Males.

Priority 2

If any positions remain after Priority 1, eligible swimmers who achieve Swim BC Next Wave Consideration Times in three (3) or more events between September 1, 2024 – August 31, 2025, will be ranked by their top scoring Next Wave swim. The top ranked swimmers will be selected up to a grand total of 30 Females and 30 Males, inclusive of Priority 1.

Priority 3

Eligible swimmers who achieve Swim BC Prospects time standards in three (3) or more events between September 1, 2025 – March 31, 2026, will be selected to the Swim BC Prospects Provincial Team in addition to the 30 Males and 30 Females identified in Priorities 1 or 2.

The top ranked swimmers will be selected up to a grand total of 10 Females and 10 Males, inclusive of Priority 1.

Priority 3

Eligible swimmers who achieve Swim BC Advance time standards in three (3) or more events between September 1, 2025 – March 31, 2026, will be selected to the Swim BC Advance Provincial Team in addition to the 30 Males and 30 Females identified in Priorities 1 or 2.
